

2013 Bible Reading Plan

A calendar that includes daily readings covering

the whole Bible in one year,

in a thematic fashion.

Description and Examples

This Bible reading schedule is thematic or connective in nature. The goal is to make as many associations as possible between the different parts of Scripture while still reading individual books of the Bible from start to finish. Only the Psalms are not read in consecutive order. The Psalms are individually apportioned throughout the year to increase the number of connections that can be observed and appreciated.

Examples of the thematic approach in this year's plan:

Jan 1: Psalm 148 (a creation Psalm), Genesis 1 (creation), and Ephesians 1 (chosen in Christ before the foundation of the world)
Feb 8: Exodus 19 and 1 Peter 2 (a kingdom of priests and a holy nation)
Mar 13: Psalm 135 and Numbers 21 (defeat of Sihon and Og)
Apr 18: Psalm 1 and Joshua 1 (meditation on the law of God day and night)
May 30: 2 Samuel 11-12 and Psalm 51 (David's fall into sin and his confession of that sin)
June 18: 1 Kings 17 and 1 Corinthians 15 (resurrection)
June 24: 2 Kings 4 and Mark 5 (children raised from the dead)
July 13: Malachi 3:1 and 4:6 with Luke 1:17 (John the Baptist as Elijah)
Aug 12: 2 Chronicles 18:18-22 and 2 Thessalonians 2:11-12 (God sending a spirit of deception)
Sept 23: Psalm 107:23-32 and Jonah 1 (the Lord sending storms on the sea)
Oct 8: Jeremiah 31:31-34 and Hebrews 8:8-12 (a new covenant)
Nov 23: Psalm 142:7 (bring me out of prison) and Acts 12 (Peter's imprisonment and subsequent delivery)
Dec 30: Isaiah 65-66 and Revelation 21-22 (the new heavens and new earth)

There are many other connections, both major and minor, besides these. With many of the Psalms used in this manner, the number of connections in the 2013 plan are easily in excess of 100.

Acknowledgements

The editor is indebted to a great number of men who laid the foundation for these plans, many of whose names are lost to history. Chief among those who are known are: Robert Murray M'Cheyne, Scottish pastor and the creator of the world-renowned M'Cheyne Bible Reading Plan, and R. A. Torrey, compiler of the Treasury of Scripture Knowledge. Frequent use has also been made of the cross-reference systems found in the New American Standard Bible, the English Standard Version, the 4th edition of the UBS Greek New Testament, and the 27th edition of Novum Testamentum Graece.
