

# 2014 Bible Reading Plan

A calendar that includes daily readings covering  
the whole Bible in one year,  
in a thematic fashion.

## *Description and Examples*

This Bible reading schedule is thematic or connective in nature. The goal is to make as many associations as possible between the different parts of Scripture while still reading individual books of the Bible from start to finish. Only the Psalms are not read in consecutive order. The Psalms are individually apportioned throughout the year to increase the number of connections that can be observed and appreciated.

Each year's plan is different. This year's plan begins with Genesis and 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy.

Examples of the thematic approach in this year's plan:

Jan 1: Psalm 19 (a creation Psalm) with Genesis 1 (creation)

Jan 6: Holding wealth with a light hand, found in all three texts – Genesis 14:22-24, Psalm 112:3-5, and 1 Timothy 6:17-19

Mar 28: Deuteronomy 5 and Matthew 5: the law of God, and Jesus' further explanation of that law in the Sermon on the Mount

April 19: Psalm 22:1 and Matthew 27:46: "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

June 3: 2 Samuel 11-12 and Psalm 51, David's fall into sin and his confession of that sin

Aug 31: Trouble in the church: Jeremiah's difficulties with opposing prophets, and John's difficulties with Diotrephes, Jeremiah 28-29 and 3<sup>rd</sup> John 1

Sept 9: 1<sup>st</sup> John 1 and Psalm 32, confession of sin

Dec 1<sup>st</sup>: John 19 and Colossians 1 and 2: the cross of Christ

This only a small sample of what is to be found in this Bible reading plan. There are many other connections, both major and minor, besides these. With most of the Psalms used in this manner, the number of days with connections exceeds one hundred. There is, however, no regular interval within which a day with these connections occurs. It is entirely possible that the reader may go as many as three weeks without seeing anything of a substantially similar nature between the day's readings, but at other times, the connections will come thick and fast.

## *Acknowledgements*

The editor is indebted to a great number of men who laid the foundation for these plans, many of whose names are lost to history. Chief among those who are known are: Robert Murray M'Cheyne, Scottish pastor and the creator of the world-renowned M'Cheyne Bible Reading Plan, and R. A. Torrey, compiler of the Treasury of Scripture Knowledge. Frequent use has also been made of the cross-reference systems found in the New American Standard Bible, the English Standard Version, and the 27<sup>th</sup> edition of Novum Testamentum Graece.
